

## HLT55115 Diploma of Dental Technology

### Course Timetable and Duration

#### 1. Full Time study mode: 1360 hours (95 weeks including holidays)

The classes are allocated 2 days per week for face to face learning sessions. Attendance is compulsory for these sessions. There would be time expected for students to spend for self study (approximately 4 to 8 hours per week). Please contact Menzies Institute of Technology regarding the available class timetable days.

All theoretical and practical sessions are done at the Menzies School of Dental Health campus and involve face-to-face delivery, practical demonstrations, in class activities and assessments.

Menzies School of Dental Health offers **CAD – CAM training incorporated** in the Diploma of Dental Technology course using the latest equipment and software from 3Shape and TRIOS.

It is absolutely vital that all students/graduates of Dental Technology are familiar with CAD-CAM technologies to **open new employment opportunities as Digital Dental Technicians** that can be used in anywhere in the world. You will be equipped with skills and knowledge in both traditional dental technology and modern CAD – CAM processes that will make you into a highly skilled and sought after as a Digital Dental Technician.

#### 2. Apprenticeship/traineeship and block release study (3 years)

The student must have suitable workplace employment and Menzies Institute can arrange flexible block release study arrangements with the employer.

Students with this study mode will attend classes at Menzies for 1 week every 2 to 3 months depending on the arrangement with the employer.
